Doctor of Māori Development and Advancement (MDA) and Doctor of Indigenous Development and Advancement (IDA) are doctoral degrees designed for students in professional areas. They consider the working experiences of students and encourages them to consider how their research can contribute to the community or indigenous organisations they are in.

Choosing the right degree

The point of difference between the two degrees is that the IDA is primarily for those who work in an indigenous context or have a responsibility for indigenous aspects within their employment, including international students. The MDA is primarily for those who are employed within Māori organisations, for example iwi or government context.
